



THE UNIVERSITY OF CHICAGO PHD PROGRAM IN EAST ASIAN CINEMA

The University of Chicago announces the formation of a joint PhD program in East Asian cinema, a result of collaboration between the Program in Cinema and Media Studies and the Department of East Asian Languages and Civilizations.

The University of Chicago has long-standing engagement with both Film and East Asian studies and has already graduated a number of scholars who are changing the field of East Asian cinema around the world. The purpose of this degree program is to provide the best possible training in the methods, languages, and cultural contexts needed to undertake original research on specific topics in East Asian cinema and media studies.

The benefits of the joint degree will come from the intellectual linkage of fields that are often kept separate by lack of a shared methodology and tradition of research. Faculty working together on the joint degree will develop shared research programs that will help prepare students to do groundbreaking work and lead the next generation of East Asian film scholars.
