

# DISSERTATION WRITING FELLOWSHIPS FOR 2009-2010

## CHINA, JAPAN, KOREAN AND TAIWAN STUDIES

The Center for East Asian Studies announces the availability of a limited number of fellowships for advanced graduate students. These fellowships are exclusively for dissertation writing; **only students who have completed their dissertation research** are eligible to apply.

**There are no application forms --- applicants should submit the following materials:**

1. A statement from your department indicating that you have been **admitted to candidacy**. If a letter is on file from a previous application, this step is not necessary; however you need to confirm with the Center that the letter is still on file.
2. Two letters of recommendation.
3. A dissertation proposal and **one complete** chapter.
4. A statement of purpose (of no more than two pages), which is a statement of work you plan to do on your dissertation during the year.

A student can receive only **one** dissertation writing fellowship from the Center and this award will be the final financial assistance to be given a student by the Center.
